## Information for Coaches & Teams

### Game Day Requirements

- **Arrival:** Do not arrive at the game site more than **60 minutes** prior to your game.
- **Team Check In:** Teams must enter the team gate all at once.
- **Rosters:** Submit a full roster with the starting line-up and phonetic pronunciations to the press box **20 minutes** before the game.
- **Warm-ups:** Minimum field time is 15 minutes for semifinals and 20 minutes for championships. Teams must provide their own warm-up balls.
- **Ball Holders:** Each team must furnish at least three ball-holders to check in with the referee immediately following the pre-game conference.
- **Credentials:** Coaches are required to wear their UHSAA-provided credentials at all times.

### Field & Facility Logistics

- **Jerseys:** The **higher seed** is the **home team** and wears the **home jersey**; the lower seed wears the visitor jersey.
- **Locker Rooms:** Available at both sites but **must be cleared out at halftime** to allow the next team access.
- **Benches:** Home teams occupy the bench to the left of the substitution area (when looking at the field). Canopies are not allowed.
- **Water:** Westminster University and ZBS provide water (teams must bring their own ice).

- **Game Balls:** Game balls will be furnished for the semi-finals and finals by the UHSAA. Teams must furnish their own warm-up balls for all games.
- **Surface Protection:** No liquids other than plain water (no Gatorade/Powerade) are allowed on playing surfaces and team benches.
  - **Dumping liquids on the playing area and team bench is strictly prohibited.**
  - **Teams must clean their bench areas immediately after the game.**
- **Team Audio or Music:** Teams will NOT be allowed to play any music inside the venue.

## Administration & School Personnel

- **Crowd Management:** Principals and/or Assistant Principals are responsible for student supervision and must provide a cell phone number to game management upon check-in.
- **Security:** School Resource Officers (SROs) should check in with game management and are recommended for championship games.
- **Official Flag:** Only one designated school flag is allowed at the tournament and must be controlled by administration.

## Fan & Spectator Information

### Ticketing & Entry

- **Digital Tickets:** All tickets must be purchased via the [UHSAA GoFan site](#).
- **Pricing:** Adults are **\$13.00**; Students and Seniors are **\$8.00**.
- **Entry Time:** Gates open 1 hour before the first game.

### Bag Policy

Zions Bank Stadium has a strict NO BAG policy. Please do not bring bags to the stadium as bags will not be allowed through the gate.

### Prohibited Items

With the exception of UHSAA corporate sponsors, there are to be no banners or signs of any kind displayed at the state tournament. One school flag, designated and controlled by school administration, will be allowed at the State Tournament. It may be mobile if it does not disrupt spectators and remains on the sidelines nearest the school's section. For a comprehensive list of prohibited items at the lacrosse state tournament, please consult the UHSAA Handbook and the State Event Guidelines. Stadiums prohibit additional items, please see the list below.

#### Prohibited Items

- Weapons of any kind including, but not limited to, knives, pepper spray, stun guns, concealed weapons and firearms
- Fireworks of any kind including, but not limited to, flares, smoke bombs, incendiary devices and pyrotechnics
- Illegal drugs or harmful chemicals
- Any missile or projectile like object
- Aerosol cans or pressurized containers
- Professional camera equipment; tripods, battery packs, large commercial video cameras
- Laser pointers
- Remote controlled aircraft (drones)

- Bottles, cans, coolers, containers or food or beverage of any kind
- Plastic horns, air horns, whistles, vuvuzelas
- Pets (with the exception of service dogs) – Beginning on March 15, 2011, only dogs are recognized as service animals under titles II and III of the ADA
- Confetti Canisters
- Canopies and tents
- Any other items deemed to be inappropriate or dangerous by the Event Manager

## Parking Guidelines

- **Westminster (Semifinals):** Free parking is available in the structure underneath Dumke Field (accessed via 1700 South and 1200 East).
- **Zions Bank Stadium (Finals):** Fans may park in any stadium lot.
- **Bus Parking:** Buses at Westminster must use the designated enclave west of the athletic center; at Zions Bank, buses drop off on the south side and park per the provided map.
