YAC will provide input and leadership to our Association and also play a key role in implementing activities in your school

which promote a positive and inclusive school climate for all students with the support of Special Olympics Utah and Project Unify (federal funds available).

Dare2Lead Conference Details:

- The 2015 Dare2Lead Conference will be held on Thursday, June 18, at Murray High (5440 So. State).
- The conference begins at 9:00 am and ends at 5:30 pm following dinner.
- Participants will receive a conference t-shirt, Dare2Lead booklet, wrist band, continental breakfast, lunch, bowling and dinner.
- There is no cost to the student; the <u>UHSAA will bill schools \$25 for each participant;</u> there will be an additional \$25 charge for each student requesting hotel accommodations.
- The UHSAA will make arrangements for those requesting hotel accommodations at the Crystal Inn at 818 East Winchester Street (6400 South). Confirmations will be emailed the week prior.
- We expect approximately 220 students to be in attendance at the conference, representing high schools from across the state.
- Special Olympics Utah will discuss the responsibilities of YAC (Youth Activation Committee) in our schools and introduce the students to Project Unify (leadership, inclusion & sports).
