Live UHSAA Demonstration Clinic at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 4, at Corner Canyon High School

The purpose of this clinic is to create a common understanding between those that penalize and those that perform. We want coaches, judges and choreographers to have a clear understanding of what skills are legal and what are not legal before they spend a summer working on their competition routines. We will also address the NFHS Spirit Rules changes for 2015-16. Coaches, judges and choreographers are encouraged to attend this voluntary clinic at 9 a.m. on Saturday, June 4, in the Corner Canyon High School's gymnasium. There will be a \$5.00 entrance fee for the clinic.

UHSAA Rules Clinic at Olympus High School, Saturday, August 29, 9:00 -11:00 a.m.

The UHSAA requires Head Coaches, Judges and Competition Directors to attend the live UHSAA Drill Rules Clinic on Saturday, <u>August 29, from 9-11 a.m. in the Olympus High School LECTURE HALL (4055 So. 2300 E.)</u> OR complete the online UHSAA Drill Rules Clinic and quiz by the designated deadline (this option for coaches only). The online UHSAA Rules Clinic will be available under the "Training" tab at <u>www.uhsaa.org</u> a few days following the live clinic. Schools will be fined \$50 if the head coach has not completed the live or online and quiz by the deadline. We encourage everyone to attend the live rules clinic. <u>NEW THIS YEAR: This clinic will be broadcast LIVE via Google Hangouts/You Tube. Those who login from home</u> <u>will have the option to ask questions. It will also be available to view at a later date. Instructions on how to be a part of the Live Clinic from the comfort of your own home will be sent soon! UHSAA Judges' Live Training Clinics

Prior to attending one of the following live Judges' Training Clinics, judges should first register, pay the registration fee, attend the live rules clinic or complete the online rules clinic and quiz. After August 10, judges must register and pay their fee at the live training clinic a rules book will be provided at that time. Judges are required to attend one of the following LIVE Judging Practicums. Following the judges' clinic, judges must complete a test on the UHSAA Drill Rules and the NFHS Spirit Rules that pertain to Drill Team, available under the Training tab at <u>www.uhsaa.org</u>. A minimum score of 80% must be earned on the online rules test by the designated deadline. For post-season consideration (state competition) judges should also attend the fall UDJA training.
