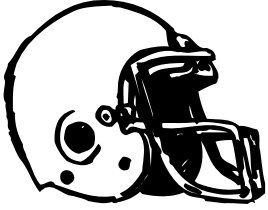

2010 UTAH HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS TOURNAMENT INFORMATION



Your attention to the following items will help make the playoffs successful. IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PRINCIPAL TO INFORM STAFF and STUDENTS ABOUT THESE REGULATIONS. Please make copies for your coach and band teacher.

1. The principal or assistant principal is responsible for the supervision of his/her students at all times. The principal or the person designated to be in charge of the students should report to one of the UHSAA directors prior to each game and identify where he/she will be sitting. Students must be supervised at playoff sites at all times. School administration must assist in keeping students off the field at the end of the game. Do not leave team members in the change room areas without adult supervision. Change rooms will be checked as you enter and damages will be reported. Schools will be charged for any damages which occur. The UHSAA is not responsible for lost or stolen articles. You must secure your own valuables.

2. All team members (in uniforms), coaches, stats people, and bench personnel will be admitted as a group through the appropriate gate under the supervision and direction of the head coach. The number of individuals allowed on the sideline must be controlled by the administration. If a person has no justification for being on the sideline, they will be removed by the game management. Children under the ninth grade may not be on the field or the sideline. THIS INCLUDES BALL-BOYS.

3. Everyone including bus drivers, faculty members, photographers, mascots, drill teams, cheerleaders, bands etc. must have tickets. Schools will be reimbursed, at the pre-sale price, (upon receipt of a claim form listing each participant by name) to a maximum of 15 cheerleaders for each game in which your school competes. Admission prices are as follows:

Student pre-sale.....	\$5.00
Student gate.....	\$5.00
Sr. Citizens.....	\$5.00
Adults.....	\$8.00

You may pre-sell tickets at your school upon request to this office. Faculty members may purchase student pre-sale tickets for \$5.00 if tickets are purchased at their respective schools. ID will be required at the gate. No faculty tickets will be sold at the site of the games.

4. There are to be no practices at the site of the playoffs prior to the games.

5. The home team will wear dark jerseys. All uniforms must be legal. Players must furnish their own tape, locks and towels. Please ensure that players wear legal cleats with no more than 1/2 inch studs.

6. Each team must furnish any practice and warm up balls to be used. The SPALDING "J5V Advance" will be the official game ball, however any NFHS legal Spalding ball may be used. Schools may supply their own ball personnel and may use their own Spalding footballs. The UHSAA will provide Spalding footballs at the semi-finals and final games if teams do not have their own Spalding footballs.

7. Drill teams or other high school performing groups may perform at halftime. No props or novelties may be used. Each school has 3 minutes only with the home team marching first (this includes on/off time). Performing groups must purchase their own tickets for admittance to the game.

8. By Board decision the following are prohibited from the UHSAA football playoffs: 1) Electrical sound systems (We would ask that groups use their bands for warm-ups, not tapes. The high school band should have that opportunity); 2) Cannons; 3) Sirens; 4) Confetti; 5) Signs of any kind and any dimension (School flags may be displayed, though not during the flag ceremony);

9. Bands, please coordinate your playing time and please be courteous to other performing groups. Playing during "live ball" action of the field is not permitted by either band.
