RE: 3A Boys & Girls State Basketball Tournament at the Maverik Center, February 26th –February 28th, 2015

Welcome to the Maverik Center! Have a Great Tournament

TEAMS & COACHES

1. Upon completion of your game, please remove all belongings and leave the locker room immediately. Following your game there is another team that must have access to your locker room as soon as possible.
2. Teams must enter the Maverik Center through the enclosed compound located at the north end of the building. Players and coaches will be hand stamped for a full day entrance (you must reenter at the same place if you exit the arena during the course of the day however, you may not park your car in the compound. Only buses and game official's vehicles may be parked in the compound). Coaches will designate the maximum twenty five (25) team related (players, coaches, managers, athletic trainers, etc.) persons to be stamped. Please check your dressing room assignments as you enter the Maverik Center.
3. Teams are to provide for their own medical/athletic training requirements. There will not be a tournament athletic trainer. Teams are to provide their own should they desire athletic training services.
4. Coaches: Please instruct your team as they come through the entrance to: **KEEP ALL EQUIPMENT AND BELONGINGS WITH THEM** until it is time to actually use the locker room. Teams are not to take items to the locker room, then go into the arena to watch a previous game.
5. Because of the tight time schedule, the pre-game warm up period will be a maximum of ten (10) minutes. In the unlikely event we get ahead of schedule, more time will be allotted. Later days may afford a longer warm up period.
6. The playing floor will be dust mopped at halftime, not in between games. This will allow for uninterrupted warm up periods.
7. All home teams will use the south team bench. All home teams will warm up at the north basket prior to the 1st half. All visiting teams will use the north team bench. All visiting teams will warm up at the south basket prior to the 1st half.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. **BUSES**
Team Drivers: Must drop off players and team officials / attendants in the enclosed compound located at the north end of the building. Team Drivers must then park their buses in that same enclosed area.
Cheerleader and Student Spectator Drivers: Must drop off passengers at the Maverik Center's main entrance located at the south end of the building. Cheerleader and Spectator Drivers are encouraged to egress passengers as quickly as possible in order to avoid vehicle congestion. Lastly, once Cheerleader and Spectator buses are empty, vehicles must park along the fence adjacent to I-215.
2. **BUILDING ENTRY** (students, general public, cheerleaders, ADA persons)
 - Students and General public must enter through the main entrance (Grand Lobby).
 - Cheerleaders must enter through the will-call entrance adjacent to the main entrance (ground level, left side).
 - ADA can enter through the will-call entrance adjacent to the main entrance (ground level, left side).

3. **STUDENT SECTIONS**

Home Team: Students: Sections 125 & 126
Non-Students: Sections 114 & 115
Band: Section on the southeast corner of the floor adjacent to the south basket.

Visiting Team: Students: Sections 101 & 102
Non-Students: Sections 112 & 113
Band: Section on the northeast corner of the floor adjacent to the north basket.

4. **PARKING:**

All vehicles (excluding team buses, those with UHSAA passes, and game official's vehicles) will be required to pay a \$3.00 parking fee.

5. **HALFTIME PERFORMANCES** (Must be school sponsored performers)

- Each student body will be allowed to use three (3) minutes at the half-time intermission (this includes entering and exiting the court).
- The home team performs first.
- There are no dressing facilities for half-time performers.
- Music and scripts for the announcer are to be delivered to the sound booth/scorer's table upon arrival. Coordination should come through the advisor/coach or school administrator for half-time performances.

No outside food or drink will be allowed in the Maverik Center (for patrons, teams, and officials alike). Large containers and backpacks are also discouraged and subject to search. All patrons will need to go through a security checkpoint upon entering the Maverik Center. Please allow enough time to enter the building.
