Boys' Final: 3/6 at 6:45 p.m.

Team Entry

- 1) Players, coaches and team personnel will enter through the tunnel from the exterior of the arena. This entrance is only to be used by these groups and officials. Each head coach will designate 25 people for access to the game. Anyone over that list will be required to have paid admittance to the game/games.
- 2) Please instruct your team that as they come through the entrance to keep all equipment and belongings with them until it is time to use the locker room. Do not take items to the locker room then go into the arena to watch a game.
- 3) All team personnel and support groups must be wearing face masks properly when entering the facility and when in the arena.

Ticket Policy

Ticketing policies will be released to schools and fans in the days before the tournament. UHSAA will coordinate with member schools regarding tickets for support groups. Students will be required to purchase tickets. Ticket policies are subject to change due to COVID-19 risk mitigation optimization in the facility. **Tickets will be for one game and the facility will be cleared after the conclusion of each game.**

COVID-19 Mitigation Policy

The Sevier Valley Center will enforce the proper wearing of masks, along with strongly encouraging physical distancing, for all spectators who attend the 1A state tournament. Failure to comply with this rule will be considered grounds for removal from the facility. Additionally, all participants who aren't actively physically exerting themselves will be required to wear face masks. Support groups will be required to wear masks. **Tickets will be for one game only and the facility will be cleared after the conclusion of each game.**

Prohibited Items

- Signs
- Weapons

- Signs are not allowed, per UHSAA policy. If you bring a sign and wish to have it stored, please give it to an usher and they will instruct you on how to retrieve it after the game.

Athletic Training

An athletic trainer will be available to teams at the venue. However, teams are strongly encouraged to bring a trainer with their team if one is available and they are also strongly encouraged to bring all necessary training supplies with them to the tournament.

Locker Room Policy

- 1) Locker room assignments will be available as teams enter the arena. The locker room assignments will also be noted on the locker room door.
- 2) Upon completion of your game remove all belongings and leave the locker room immediately. Following your game there is another team that must have access to your locker room as soon as possible.
- 3) Any damage to the locker rooms will be noted and your school will be invoiced for the expenses.
- 4) SVC is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Teams are responsible to secure their own valuables.

Cheerleaders and Drill Team Guidelines

Halftime Performances: (Must be school sponsored performers)

Each student body will be allowed to use **three (3)** minutes at the half-time intermission with the home team performing first. (This includes getting on and off the court.) There are no dressing facilities for half-time performers. Please get your music and scripts to the sound booth/scorers table as soon as possible upon arrival and must be completed before the game begins. Coordination should come through the advisor/coach or school administrator for half-time festivities.

Notes for Teams

The playing floor will be swept at halftime, not between games. This will allow for uninterrupted warm up period.

Support Groups

Schools will be allowed a maximum of 15 cheerleaders on the floor at any one time. All support groups are to come to games ready to perform as there will be minimal time between games to set up.

Streaming

No video streaming or filming can take place at any time during the tournament, outside of the team film. This is due to the Association's agreement with Deseret Digital Media to provide streaming for UHSAA championships. Venues will mark positions designated for television, streaming and team film.
