Coaches Credentials

Coaches are required to wear their UHSAA-issued credentials for certified coaches when coaching in games, or when on-site at the venue.

Team Entry

- 1) Players, coaches, and team personnel will enter through the tunnel from the exterior of the arena. This entrance is only to be used by these groups and officials. Each head coach will designate 25 people who are to receive wristbands for all-day access to the tournament. Anyone over that list will be required to have paid admittance to the game/games.
- 2) Please instruct your team that as they come through the entrance to keep all equipment and belongings with them until it is time to use the locker room. Do not take items to the locker room then go into the arena to watch a game.

Cheerleaders, Drill Teams, and Pep Band

- 1) Every member of your support groups **must purchase a ticket** each time they come to the venue. Please don't show up to the venue without purchasing a ticket beforehand. The UHSAA will reimburse your school for up to (15) cheerleaders.
- 2) Please enter the venue at the General Admission doors, located on the southwest corner of the Sevier Valley Center.

Ticket Policy

The UHSAA will utilize GoFan for all ticket purchases. Fans are encouraged to pre-purchase tickets via the GoFan app or the GoFan website, via the UHSAA website. There will be no cash option for purchasing tickets; tickets can only be purchased through GoFan. The Sevier Valley Center box office will be selling tickets on-site using the GoFan system. Fans will pay a processing fee from GoFan. Fans will receive a wristband to facilitate re-entry.

NOTE: The UHSAA and the Sevier Valley Center will be keeping lists of State Pass holders and the usage of the passes at both venues, to ensure there is not an abuse of the UHSAA State Pass policy.

- Signs are not allowed, per UHSAA policy. If you bring a sign and wish to have it stored, please give it to an usher and they will instruct you on how to retrieve it after the game.

Athletic Training

An athletic trainer will be available to teams at both venues. However, teams are strongly encouraged to bring a trainer with their team if one is available and they are also strongly encouraged to bring all necessary training supplies with them to the tournament.

Locker Room Policy

- 1) Locker room assignments will be available as teams enter the arena. The locker room assignments will also be noted on the locker room door.
- 2) Upon completion of your game remove all belongings and leave the locker room immediately. Following your game there is another team that must have access to your locker room as soon as possible.
- 3) Any damage to the locker rooms will be noted and your school will be invoiced for the expenses.
- 4) SVC and RHS are not responsible for lost or stolen items. Teams are responsible to secure their own valuables.

Cheerleaders and Drill Team Guidelines

Halftime Performances: (Must be school sponsored performers)

Each student body will be allowed to use **three (3)** minutes at the half-time intermission with the home team performing first. (This includes getting on and off the court.) There are no dressing facilities for half-time performers. Please bring your music and scripts to the sound booth/scorer's table as soon as possible upon arrival and must be completed before the game begins. Coordination should come through the advisor/coach or school administrator for half-time festivities. There is a maximum of 15 cheerleaders allowed on the floor for each team at one time.

Notes for Teams

The playing floor will be swept at halftime, not between games. This will allow for an uninterrupted warm-up period.

Streaming

No video streaming or filming can take place at any time during the tournament, outside of the team film. This is due to the Association's agreement with KSL Sports.com to provide streaming for UHSAA championships. Venues will mark positions designated for television, streaming and team film.

Parking

Schools, Teams, and Fans participating at SVC west and east parking lots are available. Buses will park in the team drop off area northwest corner of SVC.
