TICKETS: The cost for tickets will be as follows:

Student: \$10.00

Adult: \$15.00

The ticket price includes all service fees associated with WSU ticketing platform.

Patrons who want to purchase tickets in person, need a credit card or cash to purchase the tickets because WSU does not have touch/tap capabilities for payments.

Teams & Coaches:

- 1). **Basketball Teams** must enter the northwest tunnel at the Dee Event Center. Players and coaches will be hand stamped which will be appropriate for full day entrance (you must reenter at the same place if you exit the arena during the course of the day). The head coach will designate the maximum twenty-five (25) to be stamped. Any extras that come in with the team will be counted and your school will be invoiced. Check dressing room assignments as you enter the Center. **Coaches, please wear your credential while you are in the arena and when you are coaching.**
- 2). Please instruct your team that s they come through the entrance to keep all equipment and belongings with them until it is time to use the locker room. Do not take items to the locker room then go into the arena to watch a game.
- 3). The home team uses the south team bench (right of scorer's table), warm up at north basket 1st half. The visiting team uses the North team bench, warm up at the north basketball 1st half.
- 4). The playing floor will be swept at halftime, not between games. This will allow for an uninterrupted warm up period.
- 5). Upon completion of your game remove all belongings and leave the locker room immediately. Following your game there is another team that must have access to your locker room as soon as possible.

Band, Cheer, and Drill Teams:

1). **EVERY PARTICIPANT NEEDS TO PURCHASE A TICKET.** Wristbands will be given at the West entrance. Please use the (West) entrance. (16) cheerleaders will be allowed on the floor to cheer during the games. Cheer coaches can substitute individuals at their discretion.

General Information:

1). Buses: Drivers please drop players, students, and support teams off at the DEC west entrance. Drivers are encouraged to park buses towards the perimeter of the parking lot on the West side near the ice sheet.

2). Student sections:

Home Team: Students in section B and C (portals 2 & 3), **Band in Section C (portal 3).**

Visiting Team: Students in sections U and V (portals 19 & 20), **Band in Section V (portal 20).**

3). **Section A** is a buffer zone and will be closed to public seating. No person is allowed in this section.

4). **Halftime Performances:** (Must be 1 school sponsored performance).

Each student body will be allowed to use three (3) minutes at the half-time intermission with the home team performing first. (This includes getting on and off the court). There are no dressing facilities for half-time performers. Please get your digital music format to the soundbooth at portal (2) as soon as possible. Coordination should come through the advisor/coach or school administration.

5). No **OUTSIDE** food or drink will be allowed at the Dee Events Center.

6). **CLEAR BAG POLICY:** To provide a safer environment for the public and expedite entry into venues, WSU only allows clear 12x12x6 plastic, vinyl or PVC bags to be brought into games and events. Exceptions to this policy will be made for all medically necessary items after proper inspection.

Only clear diaper bags are permitted in the event center and stadium. Guests must have the infant(s) for which the bag is being carried present when the bag is searched, bags are permitted in the event center and stadium. 7). Everyone coming to the games will pass through a security checkpoint at each entrance; please allow plenty of time to enter the arena.

8). **School Resource Officers** please check in with WSU Police Officers, located at portal (17), upon arrival.

9). Please bring your team **trainers** to Weber State for the tournament.

10). WSU would like to invite your administrators to be present in between games when students are getting their seats. There's typically some pushing and shoving when students are leaving because their game is over, and those students coming in for the following game. Please help out with this transition.
