Team Entry

- Players, coaches and team personnel will enter through the tunnel from the exterior of the arena. This entrance is only to be used by these groups and officials. Each head coach will designate 25 people who are to receive handstamps for all-day access to the tournament. Anyone over that list will be required to have paid admittance to the game/games.
- 2) Please instruct your team that as they come through the entrance to keep all equipment and belongings with them until it is time to use the locker room. Do not take items to the locker room then go into the arena to watch a game.

Ticket Policy

Fans will be required to purchase a ticket at either the Sevier Valley Center or Richfield High School for the day's action. A ticket purchased at one location will be valid entry to both locations. Fans will need to ensure that their hands are stamped to allow for ease of access in both venues. An ATM will be available for fans wishing to purchase tickets with cash, to avoid any processing fees. Online tickets will be available through the UHSAA's ticket partner, Tik-A-Tap, at the UHSAA website's Tournament Central page.

Prohibited Items

- Confetti
- Silly String
- Air Horns
- Balloons
- Signs
- Weapons
- Food & Drink (1 bottle of water is allowed)
- Additional items as listed on the UHSAA website
- Signs are not allowed, per UHSAA policy. If you bring a sign and wish to have it stored, please give it to an usher and they will instruct you on how to retrieve it after the game.

Athletic Training

An athletic trainer will be available to teams. However, teams are strongly encouraged to bring a trainer with their team if one is available and they are also strongly encouraged to bring all necessary training supplies with them to the tournament.

Locker Room Policy

1) Locker room assignments will be available as teams enter the arena. The locker room assignments will also be noted on the locker room door.

- 2) Upon completion of your game remove all belongings and leave the locker room immediately. Following your game there is another team that must have access to your locker room as soon as possible.
- 3) Any damage to the locker rooms will be noted and your school will be invoiced for the expenses.

Cheerleaders and Drill Team Guidelines

Halftime Performances: (Must be school sponsored performers) Each student body will be allowed to use three (3) minutes at the half-time intermission with the home team performing first. (This includes getting on and off the court.) There are no dressing facilities for half-time performers. Please get your music and scripts to the sound booth/scorers table as soon as possible upon arrival and must be completed before the game begins. Coordination should come through the advisor/coach or school administrator for half-time festivities.

Notes for Teams

The playing floor will be swept at halftime, not between games. This will allow for uninterrupted warm up period.

Streaming

No video streaming or filming can take place at any time during the tournament, outside of the team film. This is due to the Association's agreement with Deseret Digital Media to provide streaming for UHSAA championships. Venues will mark positions designated for television, streaming and team film.
