

Board of Trustees Meeting Summary
March 25, 2021

1. Chairman Jerre Holmes called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone.
2. Mr. Rob Cuff, Executive Director, provided the Committee with a list of winter state champions and a basketball endowment game financial report. The endowment game revenue is currently used to supplement schools' annual catastrophic insurance.
3. The UHSAA staff reviewed winter activities, which included wrestling, basketball, drill team and swimming.
4. Mr. Brent Strate provided a USBE Report.
5. Mr. Jeff Cluff, Supervisor of Officials, reviewed the winter ejection reports for coaches and players. The emphasis in sportsmanship has helped the respect and relationships between coaches and officials improve.
6. Mr. Jon Oglesby reviewed the 2020-2021 calendar (www.uhsaa.org) and the 2021-2022 tentative calendar (www.uhsaa.org) was discussed.
7. Ms. Jan Whittaker discussed the UHSAA sportsmanship initiative and encouraged all schools and/or regions to support the initiative by increasing the awareness of good sportsmanship.
8. The UHSAA Dare2LEAD Student Leadership Conference will be held in the fall by region or on a multi-region basis. More information will be provided by the UHSAA staff at the beginning of the school year.
9. Mr. Oglesby reported on Unified Sports in soccer and track & field. The UHSAA and SOUT (Special Olympics Utah) are once again joining together to provide this outstanding experience for student athletes.
10. Mr. Brenan Jackson discussed the 2021 summer moratorium and coaches' certification.
11. The Board of Trustees approved the sanctioning of cheerleading for the 2021-2022 school year. The first UHSAA sanctioned cheer competitions will be held during the 2022-2023 school year. The Board of Trustees did not approve the sanctioning of boys' volleyball and Esports.
12. Mr. Mark Van Wagoner, UHSAA legal counsel, provided a report to the Committee.

13. Mr. Cuff provided the members with articles from the NFHS Today reflecting the great things our student athletes are accomplishing in their experiences through education-based high school activities.
14. Mr. Cuff announced the Distinguished Service Award Winners. He also announced the Heart of the Arts and Spirit of Sport Award winners.
15. Elections for representatives to the Board of Trustees for 4A School Board, 3A School Board and private schools will be April 27 at the UHSAA offices.
