STATE Cheer - OVERALL Champion Calculation

As stated in the 2022-2023 UHSAA Handbook: There will be separate overall state classification champions for the All Girl and Co-Ed show divisions. Overall state classification and division champions will be awarded at the UHSAA State Cheer Championship only. Overall classification winners will be determined by:

70% (SHOW Total* Points) + 30% (GAME TIME 1 Total* Points + GAME TIME 2 Total* Points + GAME TIME 3 Total* Points)

*Total scores include the subtraction of safety penalties and deductions

On their own, the Show division and combined Game Time divisions are NOT weighted equally.

In order to make each division equal, the Show score will be multiplied by nine (9). That makes both the Show and Game Time divisions worth a possible 900 points. After a team's Show score has been multiplied by nine (9), the Overall Champion will be calculated using the formula above. For example:
