PARKING

- PARKING IS AVAILABLE IN ANY UNIVERSITY PARKING LOTS, WITH PREFERENCE GIVEN TO LOTS K, M, S, N, AND O FOR THE FOOTBALL GAMES. ALL LOTS ARE MARKED IN THE ATTACHED CAMPUS MAP
- PLEASE DO NOT PARK IN LOTS THAT ARE MARKED WITH SIGNAGE AS RESERVED AS CLOSED

VIP PARKING

 A VIP PARKING LOT WILL BE PROVIDED IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO THE STADIUM, THE PASSES FOR THAT LOT WILL BE DESIGNATED BY UHSAA ADMINISTRATORS AND THE LOT WILL BE CONTROLLED BY PARKING ATTENDANTS

TEAM BUS PARKING

 TEAMS WILL BE DROPPED OFF AT THE SOUTH EAST ENTRANCE TO THE STADIUM, LOT P, ENTERING FROM 600 SOUTH. BUSES WILL THEN NEED TO MOVE AND PARK IN PARKING LOT K, ON 1000 E. IN THE DESIGNATED BUS PARKING. BUS PARKING IS NOTED ON THE ATTACHED MAP AS WELL.

STUDENT BUS PARKING

• STUDENT BUSES WILL BE DROPPING OFF ON THE NORTH EAST SIDE OF THE STADIUM, AT THE SOUTH END OF 800 EAST. THIS CAN BE REACHED BY TAKING EXIT 8- ST. GEORGE BLVD. FROM THE I-15, TURNING LEFT

ONTO 1000 EAST, CONTINUING ONTO 400 SOUTH AND THEN TURNING LEFT ON 800 EAST. ALL BUS PARKING WILL BE LOCATED IN LOT K ON 1000 EAST AND DESIGNATED WITH SIGNAGE. BUS PARKING IS NOTED ON THE ATTACHED MAP AS WELL.

ADA PARKING

 THE ADA PARKING WILL BE LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE STADIUM, CLEARLY MARKED. ADA PARKING IS NOTED ON THE MAP AS WELL.

ADA SEATING

ADA SEATING WILL BE AVAILABLE ON BOTH THE WEST AND EAST SIDES
OF THE STADIUM AND WILL BE A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED. EACH
PERSON IN THE ADA SEATING WILL BE ALLOWED A COMPANION WHO
WILL ALSO BE PROVIDED A CHAIR IN THE ADA SEATING. ADA SEATING
FILLS FAST, IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT ANYONE WITH ADA NEEDS
ARRIVES EARLY.

STUDENT/GENERAL PUBLIC SEATING

- ALL SEATING WILL BE GENERAL ADMISSION. THERE WILL NOT BE A STUDENT SECTION PROVIDED.
- THE HOME TEAM WILL BE LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE STADIUM.
- THE VISITING TEAM WILL BE LOCATED ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE STADIUM.
- ALL ENTRANCES TO THE STADIUM WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR ENTRY TO THE GAMES. THE EAST SIDE HAS MORE GATES AND PARKING AVAILABLE AND IS RECOMMENDED FOR ENTRANCE.

BAND, CHEER, DRILL SEATING

 IF YOU ARE BRINGING A BAND, CHEER, AND DRILL TEAM, SEATING WILL NEED TO BE IN THE SAME SECTION FOR EACH MEMBER. FOR SOCIAL DISTANCING PURPOSES, SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS NEED TO PURCHASE THESE TICKETS IN THE SAME SECTION. POWER IS NOT PROVIDED.

COVID-19

- FACE COVERINGS ARE REQUIRED FOR THE DURATION OF THE EVENT
- EACH PARTICIPANT IN A SCHOOL ACTIVITY MUST ATTEST THEY ARE FREE OF COVID-19 SYMPTOMS, AND THEY HAVE NOT BEEN IN CLOSE CONTACT (WITHIN 6' FOR 15 MINUTES OR MORE) WITH A COVID POSITIVE CASE IN THE LAST 14 DAYS PRIOR TO PARTICIPATION.
- ROSTER OR LIST OF PARTICIPANTS AND THEIR CONTACT INFORMATION MUST BE MAINTAINED WHEN ENGAGING IN FORMAL COMPETITIVE EVENTS TO ASSIST WITH CONTACT TRACING EFFORTS WHEN PHYSICAL DISTANCING IS NOT FEASIBLE.
- CONGREGATING AT ANY POINT IS NOT ALLOWED
- THERE WILL ONLY BE CONTACTLESS PAYMENT OPTIONS AVAILABLE

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- NOISEMAKERS INCLUDING THUNDER STICKS, MUSICAL INSTRUMENTS, WHISTLES, AIR HORNS AND BOOM BOXES
- WEAPONS OR PROJECTILES
- ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
- GLASS, METAL OR HARD PLASTIC CONTAINERS OF ANY SIZE
- HARD OR SOFT SIDED COOLERS OF ANY SIZE
- PLASTIC DRINK CONTAINERS (EXCEPT 2 LITERS OR LESS WITH FACTORY SEAL INTACT)
- BACKPACKS, BAGS AND PURSES LARGER THAN 14" SQUARE
- BOXES OR WRAPPED PACKAGES OF ANY SIZE
- UNSLICED FRUITS OR VEGETABLES
- ANIMALS (OTHER THAN SERVICE ANIMALS REQUIRED BECAUSE OF A DISABILITY)
- BALLS, TOYS OR SPORTS EQUIPMENT
- HELIUM BALLOONS
- LASER POINTERS
- POLES OR STICKS
- SKATES, SKATEBOARDS, SCOOTERS OR BICYCLES

ELEVATOR POLICY

 THERE IS NO ELEVATOR IN THE STADIUM, THERE IS ADA SEATING AVAILABLE ON BOTH THE WEST AND EAST SIDE OF THE STADIUM.

TEAM ENTRANCE

ALL FIELD PASSES MUST BE VISIBLE AT ALL TIMES.

 ALL TEAMS WILL ENTER FROM THE SOUTH EAST ENTRANCE, HEADING DIRECTLY NORTH ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE TRACK TO THEIR LOCKER ROOMS, ENTERING FROM THE TRACK.

LOCKER ROOMS

 ALL LOCKER ROOMS ARE LOCATED IN THE EAST GRANDSTAND OF THE STADIUM. LOCKER ROOMS WILL BE MARKED AS HOME AND VISITING TEAMS. IF THERE IS A DOUBLE HEADER GAME, THE FIRST GAME TEAMS WILL BE REQUIRED TO CLEAR OUT OF THE LOCKER ROOM AT HALF-TIME TO MAKE SPACE FOR THE UPCOMING GAMES TEAMS AND ALLOW FOR LOCKER ROOM CLEAN UP.

TEAM BENCHES

- THE HOME TEAM BENCHES ARE LOCATED ON THE WEST SIDE OF THE
 FIFLD
- THE VISITING TEAM BENCHES ARE LOCATED ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE
 FIFLD
- ONLY CERTIFIED AND CREDENTIALED COACHES WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE SIDELINE. YOU MUST HAVE YOUR CREDENTIAL VISIBLE AT ALL TIMES.
- TEAMS WILL BE LIMITED TO "70" PLAYERS ON THE SIDELINE. PLEASE
 USE THE 80 YDS BETWEEN THE 10 YARD LINES FOR EACH PLAYER TO
 BE SOCIALLY DISTANCED. PLAYERS WHO MAY NOT GET INTO THE GAME
 SHOULD BE WEARING A MASK.
- COACHES MUST WEAR A MASK AT ALL TIMES. WE ARE GUEST AT DSU.
- TEAMS WILL ALSO BE ALLOWED (2) DOCTORS/MEDICAL, (1) CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER, AND (5) STATISTICIANS. COLORED WRISTBANDS WILL BE PROVIDED IN YOUR TEAM PACKET.

TEAM VIDEO

 TEAM VIDEO WILL BE LOCATED IN THE PRESS BOX AT THE TOP OF THE WEST SIDE GRANDSTAND

COACHES BOOTHS

 COACHES BOOTHS ARE LOCATED AT THE TOP OF THE WEST GRANDSTAND IN THE PRESS BOX, COACHES MUST BE DRESSED IN AFFILIATED CLOTHING TO GAIN ACCESS

SIDELINE EQUIPMENT

- NO HEATERS OF ANY KIND WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE SIDELINE.
- COOLERS, INDIVIDUAL WATER BOTTLES AND CUPS MUST BE
 PROVIDED BY THE HOME AND VISITING TEAMS, GREATER ZION STADIUM
 WILL PROVIDE ICE AND WATER.
- COACHES HEADSET MUST BE PROVIDED BY THE HOME & VISITING TEAM EQUIPMENT STAFF.
- CHAINS, DOWN & DISTANCE MARKERS AND END ZONE PYLONS WILL BE PROVIDED BY GREATER ZION STADIUM.

 UHSAA WILL PROVIDE THE SIDELINE CREW TO OPERATE THE CHAINS AND DOWN MARKERS.

OFFICIALS LOCKER ROOMS

 OFFICIALS LOCKER ROOMS WILL BE LOCATED ON THE SOUTH EAST CORNER OF THE STADIUM AND WILL BE LOCKED. A DSU REPRESENTATIVE WILL BRING THE WIRELESS MIC TO THE OFFICIALS. THE MIC CHECK WILL OCCUR 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO GAME TIME

CHEER & DRILL

- NO PROPS ARE ALLOWED ON THE TRACK/FIELD, INCLUDING BOXES AND ARTIFICIAL NOISE MAKERS. SIGNS ARE OKAY.
- CHEERLEADERS MAY STORE THEIR GEAR ON THE OUTER EDGE OF THE TRACK.
- THE HOME TEAM DRILL TEAM MAY USE THE WEST SIDE RESTROOMS FOR CHANGING.
- THE VISITING TEAM DRILL TEAM MAY USE THE EAST SIDE RESTROOMS FOR CHANGING.
- DRILL TEAMS WILL ENTER THE FIELD FROM THE WEST SIDE
- MUSIC FOR DRILL PERFORMANCES SHOULD BE TURNED INTO BOOTH BEFORE 20 MINUTES ON THE COUNTDOWN CLOCK.
- DRILL AND CHEER COACHES WHO COME TO DROP OFF MUSIC MUST CHECK IN WITH PRESS BOX MONITOR AND BE IN HIGH SCHOOL AFFILIATED CLOTHING FOR ENTRANCE.

NATIONAL ANTHEM

- 1 CORDLESS MIC WILL BE PROVIDED FOR THE NATIONAL ANTHEM.
- THERE WILL BE A MIC CHECK ON THE WEST SIDE 50 YARD LINE AT 20:00
 MINUTES LEFT ON THE COUNTDOWN CLOCK.
- A UHSAA REP WILL BE IN CHARGE OF MIC AND WILL QUE SINGERS
- IF NO SINGERS FROM THE HOME TEAM, THEN THE HOME TEAM PEP BAND WILL PLAY, IF DECLINED A PRE-RECORDED VERSION WILL BE PLAYED

SOUND BOOTH

 SOUND BOOTH IS LOCATED IN THE PRESS BOX. ALL MUSIC FOR HALF TIME PERFORMANCES MUST BE TURNED INTO BOOTH BEFORE 20 MINUTES ON COUNTDOWN CLOCK, FOR SOUND CHECKING.



At indoor venues the school flag must remain stationary; at outdoor venues it may be mobile if it does not disrupt spectators and remains on the sidelines nearest the school's section.
