School Administration / Student Supervision

The administration (principal and/or assistant principals) of each school is responsible for crowd management and the supervision of students at all tournament games. Students must be under adult supervision at all times. Administrators are to check in with game management and give a cell phone number so they can be reached immediately if necessary. School resource officers which accompany schools should also check in with game management.

Tie Game Procedure

If teams are tied at the end of regulation play, the overtime procedure will be as follows: a 10-minute maximum "sudden victory" overtime period will be played. The game concludes when a goal is scored. If no goal is scored prior to the conclusion of the 10-minute period, a second 10-minute maximum "sudden victory" period will be played. If at the conclusion of the second "sudden victory" overtime period, no goal has been scored, the game will move into a shootout to determine the winner. Shootout procedures are outlined in items 3, 4 & 5 on pages 86-87 of the 2016-17 NFHS Soccer Rules Book.

In accordance with rule, the designated home team will wear dark jerseys and socks, the designated visiting team will wear solid white jerseys and socks.

Prohibited Items, No Banners or Signs

With the exception of UHSAA corporate sponsors, there are to be **no** banners or signs of any kind displayed at the state tournament. One school flag, designated and controlled by school administration, will be allowed at the State Tournament. It may be mobile if it does not disrupt spectators and remains on the sidelines nearest the school's section. Rio Tinto Stadium prohibits additional items, please see the list below.

Rio Tinto Stadium Prohibited Items

- No Bottles, Cans, Coolers, Containers or Food or Beverage of any Kind
- Noisemakers No plastic horns, No air horns, No whistles
- No Fireworks, Flares, or Smoke bombs
- No Pets (with the exception of service animals)
- Umbrellas OK to be brought in; may not be opened in seating area Recommend rain ponchos.
- No Large strollers in seating bowl. Stroller check-in at East and West gate. Small strollers can be placed under seats.
- No Weapons

Anyone with an item that does not pass security measures will be asked to either take the item back to their vehicle or dispose of it. Purses, backpacks, fanny packs, diaper bags or any other bags may be brought into the stadium but will be thoroughly searched at the bag inspection area.

Student ticket prices are \$5.00 and adults are \$10.00 for semi-finals and finals. Tickets for pre-sale at your school may be requested from the UHSAA. Everyone must have a ticket including bus drivers, photographers, cheerleaders, etc.

Spectator Gates/Box Office Open 45 minutes Prior to the Initial Game

No spectators will be admitted more than 45 minutes prior to the scheduled first game at each site. Spectators in the facility earlier than 45 minutes prior to scheduled start time for the first game will be asked to re-enter through the ticket gates.

Game Balls

Game balls will be furnished for the semi-finals and finals by **Wilson**. Teams must furnish their own warm-up balls for all games.

Warm-up

For the first game scheduled at each site the field will be available for warm-up 1 hour prior to the scheduled game time. There will be a minimum 15 minute warm up period on the field between the other games at Juan Diego & Jordan. At Juan Diego, fields for warm-up are available outside but adjacent to the facility. At Rio Tinto Stadium the minimum warm-up on the field will be 20 minutes. Games will not begin earlier than scheduled.

Team Benches

At Jordan & Juan Diego, the designated home team will occupy the bench on the west side of the field; the visiting team will be on the opposite side. At Rio Tinto Stadium, the home team will occupy the team area north of the substitution area; the visiting team will occupy the south team area.

Team Admission

Team members will not need passes to enter the stadium. Teams must enter the team gate all at once.

<u>Ball Holders</u>

For semi-finals and finals, each team must furnish at least **three** ball-holders. Ball-holders must check-in with the referee immediately following the pre-game conference for station assignment.

Scoreboard / Game Time

Official game time will be kept on the stadium scoreboard for semifinals and finals.

Starting Line-up

Teams will provide a full roster which also indicates the starting line-up to the press box 20 minutes prior to the game.

Bus Parking

At Juan Diego

Buses are to enter the drop off zone immediately west of the stadium from the south. Teams will be dropped off immediately west of the stadium then proceed north to park in lot F just north of the baseball field.

At Jordan High

Buses are to enter the back gate on the west-side of the high school. Buses will pull down around the circle and face to the west. Drop students off here, and then you can park right there. First game buses need to pull forward as far as possible to allow for the next game buses to drop-off and park.

At Rio Tinto Stadium

Team Buses: Team buses will drop off teams and park in the dock area immediately south of the stadium. The entrance road to the dock area is accessed from 94th South.

Student Buses: Student buses will drop off students at the north load zone and park and pick up students on North Stadium Way (road immediately north of the stadium).

Fan Parking

At Juan Diego

Parking for fans is located in the regular school lots. All are to comply with all posted and marked parking restrictions. Vehicles parked in areas where parking is not allowed will be subject to citation, impoundment and/or towing.

At Jordan High

Parking for fans is located in the front parking lot. Use the west parking lots first.

At Rio Tinto Stadium

On-site parking will be \$5.00 per vehicle. The stadium is within walking distance of both the 90th South and 94th South TRAX stations. Fans are encouraged to use TRAX as much as possible. **No Parking** in Jordan Commons (except for restaurant patrons), **STRICTLY NO PARKING** in residential neighborhoods, vehicles will be subject to citation.

Water for Teams

Teams will provide their own water. Any liquid other than plain water (Gatorade, Powerade, etc.) must be kept entirely off of the artificial playing surfaces at Juan Diego at all times. NO containers are to be dumped on the playing surface at any venue.

TEAMS WILL CLEAN UP THEIR BENCH / TEAM AREA IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING

THEIR GAME. DO $\underline{\text{NOT}}$ DUMP OUT WATER, ICE, SPORTS DRINKS, ETC. ANYWHERE ON THE PLAYING SURFACE OR SIDELINES.
