WEIGHTS / WEIGH-INS: Weights will be scratch on Monday, Feb 15th (110, 117, 122, etc) at 8am. Weigh-ins and skin checks will be in the main gym. Please review the following weigh in rules with your team:

- 1. Weight cutting activities (spitting, exercising, etc) are prohibited in the weigh-in area (small gym). 2. Contestants shall weigh-in with a legal uniform AND a suitable undergarment.
- 3. Contestants may not leave the weigh-in area once weigh-ins begin.

LINEUPS / RECORDS:

Lineups will be due by Monday, February 8th at 11:59pm. Please include all matches in the girls record and do not include any byes from tournaments. All varsity matches your wrestlers have had during the season need to be accounted for including out of state tournaments. All wrestlers with a winning record or with seeding potential, should have all matches on t rackwrestling.com so we can verify. If they are not on t rackwrestling.com you must send Jeff Newby verification of their matches not on t rackwrestling by Sunday at 8pm. Records will be verified by the tournament director. Please be available for questions on records by the tournament director during the day Monday.

OFFICIAL SEEDING RULES FOR THE GIRLS STATE TOURNAMENT:

The seeding committee will use head to head as the number 1 criteria for seeding and then use the next 3 criteria as a guideline in determining seeds:

- 1). Win-Loss Record
- 2). Common Opponents
- 3). State Placers from USA State Wrestling (2020)

HEAD TO HEAD: Head to head entry will be available from 8:00 am until 11:59pm on Tuesday, Feb 9th.

SEEDING MEETING: Since there are **NO** divisional tournaments this year for girls, each qualified girl will be seeded into the state bracket. The GWC approved the following seeding process:

1). A UHSAA Seeding Committee will meet and seed the top 4 to 12 girl wrestlers into the state bracket, depending on the number of girls in each weight class, according to each classification. Once that is completed, coaches will be invited to a seeding meeting to look at the seeding and make adjustments as needed. Coaches need to make sure each girl wrestler and their records are put into TrackWrestling for all duals and tournaments, to ensure accurate seeds.

The seeding meeting will be on Thursday night at 6:0 0pm. We will be doing our meeting with zoom. All head coaches need to be available for the meeting. Zoom information will be sent out on Sunday.

CONCESSIONS: We will have a limited concession stand available both days. Gatorade, water, chips, candy bars, muffins, etc

TEAM ARRIVAL: Please do your best to arrive no earlier than 9:00am. Please enter at the main "gym" entrance doors and not the main school doors.

SPECTATORS: 2 Spectators per wrestler will be allowed using a ticketing system. Coaches must submit each participant's name and student ID so we can create a custom ticket for each wrestler. Ticket prices TBA.

STREAMING: We will be streaming all mats on trackwrestling.com via trackcast. The cost to watch will be \$10.

COACHING PASSES: Only certified coaches from the UHSAA coaching list will be given a coaching pass. Please make sure your coaches are on the UHSAA coaching list.
